Addressed Commonwealth Relations Office No. 406 repeated U.K. High Commissioner Delhi No. 223 and Deputy U.K. High Commissioner Lahore No. 123.

Lahore telegrams Nos. 99 and 100 to me.

Complete capitulation to Ahrars represented by Punjab Government communique is most difficult to understand. Situation is obscure and difficult to appreciate pending further information. In particular it is not clear by whose orders military have taken over. I will report further as soon as possible but telephone communication with Lahore is temporarily severed.
